

Map and Globe Skills

<u>Compass Rose</u>: a circular diagram printed on a chart or map to show the direction of north and other main points of the compass. <u>Grid System</u>: a way used to locate a place

on the map. (Latitude and Longitude)

Equator: This IMAGINARY line crosses our planet in the middle. Above it is the North Hemisphere. Below is the South Hemisphere.

Hemisphere: half of a sphere.

Map Key: Tells you what the symbols stand for.

It is found on the corner of the map.

Locator: A small map or picture of a globe that shows where an area on the main map is found in a state, on a continent, or in the world.

<u>Cardinal Directions</u>: The basic directions on a map called North, South, East, and West.

Intermediate Directions: Northeast, Northwest, Southeast, and Southwest.

Prime Meridian: An imaginary longitudinal

line that divides the Earth's Sphere into halves of East and West.

Map Scale: A ratio that compares distance on a

map to distance on Earth's surface.

<u>Inset Map</u>: a smaller map within a larger one.
